- **3.** It was built in the 14th century. The locals call this building the Church Friars. In the 16th century it was used both by the Catholics and Protestants
- 7. It was built in 1806. This is the highest church of the Main Square. It's bell is 2400 kg. You can reach its top on 94 steps.
- **8.** It is decorated with Transylvanian motives. It is used as the Primary and Secondary Grammar School of the Calvinist College.
- **9.** It has a collection of plaster replicas of Michelangelo statues.

- 1. It was named after the writer of our famous Hungarian national drama. In front of the building you can find the Column of Holy Trinity.
- 2. It was the only stone church in the region during the Turkish occupation.
- **4.** This building has shiny roof tiles and there are ceramic ornaments of plants and animals on the walls. It has green windows as in the famous Hungarian folk song '.....zöld az ablaka.'
- **5.** It has a small collection of dolls, wooden trains and board games.
- **6.** This is the pearl of the Main Square. The carillon here plays the works of Kodály, Erkel, and Bethoven every hour.
